Visit the world-class porphyry Mo deposits at Climax and

Henderson (Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold) and the carbonate-hosted Ag-Zn-Pb manto deposits at Leadville. The Climax and Henderson deposits have been the source of leading research in porphyry Mo deposits and development of exploration methods. The Leadville district is noted for its long history of production, research on carbonate-hosted Ag-Zn-Pb-(Au) deposits, and the founding of the Guggenheim mining fortune including the formation of ASARCO, Inc. An all-day visit to each of the districts will include surface tours and examination of drill core from the Climax and Henderson deposits, then numerous district stops at Leadville, including a visit to the mining museum.

Two overnight stays in Keystone will be attendee's responsibility.
