## Important Dates

### February 3, 2017 – Deadline for early registration rate.

- Register by mail or fax for convention fees and Short Courses to receive the early rate.

### February 24, 2017 – Deadline to register and pay by fax or mail.

- After this date, payment must be made onsite.

## Payment Options

Wire transfers are not accepted. Acceptable methods of payment are cheque, VISA, MasterCard or AMEX. All fees are quoted in Canadian dollars. Payment may be made in U.S. dollars using an exchange rate of CAD\$1.10 per U.S. dollar. Registrations will not be processed until full payment is received. After February 24, 2017, only payments at the Onsite Cashier counter, MTCC, South Building, Level 600, will be accepted. Onsite payments may be made beginning Friday, March 3, 2017.
