We therefore require a candidate who is able to work flexible rosters, sometimes with short notice, to align with business needs. The ideal candidate will be results focused, and have experience working in a similar role.

#### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- Support the Exploration Manager in delivering the country’s planned objectives and KPI’s in-line with the long-term Exploration Strategy and plan.
- Assist the Senior Geologist/s and Exploration Manager in the planning and scheduling of field and other activities in country.
- Assist in the development of exploration technical work programs to target economic mineralisation.
- Prepare timely, accurate and detailed reports, maps, plans and sections to meet Company requirements.
- Supervise contractors in the field to implement the plans in a safe and sustainable manner. Ensure that work is completed in accordance with the Company and regulatory requirements and standards.
- Maintain and supervise high quality geoscientific data collection and ensure that relevant information is captured.
- Assist in project appraisals, critically assess data for accuracy and quality and make objective assessments on exploration potential.

#### **Knowledge & Skills:**

- Minimum 3+ years’ experience in exploration, primarily in the gold sector.
- BSc (Hons preferred) in a Geoscience-related degree.
- Proficient in a wide range of exploration practices and techniques, including geochemistry, structural geology, geological mapping, GIS, sampling methods, drilling and geophysical interpretation.
- Able to apply appropriate modelling and analytical systems, tools and skills to develop an understanding of the target/deposit.
- Previous experience in developing, implementing and supervising exploration programs.
- Working knowledge of, and experience with, GIS and other exploration software.
- Awareness of the cultural and community aspects of exploration and the approvals and land access arrangements required.
- Good awareness and abilities to manage safety, health and environmental requirements in the workplace
- First Aid certificate equivalent or better.
