SEG STUDENT CHAPTER RWTH AACHEN UNIVERSITY

Summary of the year

As programmed in the last months of 2022, a joint seminar with the SEG student chapter of the Montanuniversität Leoben was held in hybrid format on March 13th 2023:

Tobias Fusswinkel (RWTH Aachen): "Halogens as tracers for ore deposit fluids"

and

Frank Melcher (Montanuniversität Leoben): "Trace elements in sulfide deposits from the Eastern Alps"

Dr. Tobias Fusswinkel from RWTH Aachen University showed how CI-Br-I systematics in fluid inclusions can be used as tracers for source and evolution of the fluids responsible for the mineralization in several ore deposits systems. He added about the need of more data of this type in order to be able to fully unveil the potential of this elements as fluid tracers. Immediately after, Prof Dr. Frank Melcher from Montanuniversität Leoben presented the results of some mineral analyses of sulfides, focusing on which trace elements can provide us in-depth information about the genesis of such small deposits across the Eastern Alps in Austria.

The seminar resulted in a large interest from both student chapters, and proved as a very successful way of sharing knowledge while building connections between different universities.

In addition, several events and field trips organized by the SEG student chapter in Freiberg, Germany, were shared and open to participation for any RWTH student interested.

The new board elections in January 2023 were not successful in finding enough people interested in taking over the guidance of the SEG student chapter of RWTH Aachen university, which was therefore put on standby by myself, as former president.

In October, a new group of students showed interested in taking over the SEG student chapter and therefore restarted it officially at the end of the present year.

No expenses were made since the 2022 report.

In the hope of a successful restart of activities in 2024, I renew my appreciations to SEG for the patience and the support in carrying over the student chapter.
