During this past year, the St Andrews Society of Economic Geologists Chapter undertook several activities to increase student membership and inspire students to learn more about economic geology. In the fall semester of 2021 amid Scotland's Covid-19 rules, I organized a bonfire with members of SEG as well as Staff. The bonfire was highly successful and a memorable moment for many SEG Members. In the Spring Semester, I organized for Dr. Denis Schaltter from <u>Helvetia Exploration</u> to come to St Andrew's and give a presentation on his research and career as an exploration geologist in Greenland.
