Brief Background

UVic originally became a SEG chapter in 1999, though went dormant in 2003. We have also contacted the UBC chapter so that our students involved can benefit from the opportunities of each school and hopefully provide an early network for students outside of their own schools. We plan on creating a field trip, networking experience, workshops, and a geology conference by the end of this school year to enrich our student's university experiences. Our goal is to expose our students to more facets of economic geology whilst growing their network and toolbox as junior geologists so that they find success in their early careers.

Internal Organization

UVic SEG Student Chapter Meetings

Executive meetings are held once every two weeks either in person or on zoom throughout most of the year. We coordinate with each other in person at school, through Facebook messenger, and via email, with a record of documents being readily accessible on google drive. Our academic and industry advisors are consulted via email or zoom meeting every two weeks.

Communication

Our main source of communication is through our email list and Facebook page, though special events and opportunities are sent to the UVic Earth and Ocean Sciences department and emailed to the masses. We also attend meetings put on by the Earth and Ocean Science student union at UVic who we are closely involved with as well. We use Facebook posts/events, posters, and PowerPoint presentations to display our activities and opportunities.

Financial Status

The chapter's main operating funds comes from the University of Victoria's Student Society and will be used for the funding of short courses, field trips, and David Nelles Resource Conference later in the year. We are working on securing more funding from the school, industry, and SEG during the year.

2021-2022 Plans

Since we are a new entity at UVic for this generation of students, our main goal is to engage students and inform them of the opportunities SEG provides for them. To do so, we have planned monthly networking nights, field trips to ore deposits each semester, and a resource conference hosted at UVic during February. We hope that Covid will not disturb our future plans, though if so, online events will be pursued instead.
