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Student Field Trip Travel Grants

The Society of Economic Geologists Foundation, Inc. (SEGF) sponsors up to two SEG-organized student field trips per year, and will award travel grants to qualified SEG student members selected to participate. SEG student members worldwide are encouraged to apply; preference will be given to fourth- and fifth-year undergraduate students, and to first-year graduate students. Participation is limited to 16 students per trip. Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be a student member of the Society of Economic Geologists, Inc. (SEG), or have applied for SEG student membership.
- Students must be actively enrolled at an accredited university in a course of study in economic geology as it relates to minerals exploration and ore deposits, and/or geochemistry or geophysics with applications to minerals exploration.

Note: Selection of participants is competitive; travel grants are awarded only to qualifying students.
