PORPHYRY SYSTEMS OF SOUTHERN PERU

September 16 to 22, 2012

This is No. 10 in the SEG Foundation-sponsored series of student field courses and will examine Porphyry Systems of Southern Peru, beginning in Tacna, the evening of the 16th of September, and ending in Arequipa on the 22nd. The course coincides with the SEG 2012 Conference "Integrated Exploration of Ore Deposits" being held in Lima, Peru, so that students can return to Lima to participate in the Conference. Travel within the country will be via charter motor coach (the SEG "mobile classroom"), to enable and encourage interaction between student and professional participants, and the field course leaders.

This course is open to economic geology students worldwide and to a few professional participants. Student participation is limited to 16; selection is competitive and preference will be given to SEG Student Members.
