Paper Submission Instructions: Original papers in any segment of economic geology and studies of all classes of mineral deposits will be considered for publication. Manuscripts of any length may be submitted, but only under special circumstances can papers in excess of 15,000 words, or roughly 50 typed, double-spaced pages, be accepted for publication. There are no page charges for publication. Three copies of the manuscript plus illustrations and tables, neatly typed with double spacing on opaque paper, together with glossy photocopies of the illustrations, should be sent to the Editor, MARCO T. EINAUDI, P.O. Box A-I, Stanford, CA 94309. The Editor and members of the Editorial Board will seek competent reviews of all papers before accepting or rejecting them. Limited topics may be submitted as scientific communications and will be judged by one review. They are published more rapidly than papers. Authors are asked to read "Instructions to Authors" (Vol. 94, No. 1) to ensure correct format prior to submitting manuscripts.

After material has been accepted for publication, digital files, including figures, will be required. All correspondence related to the final copy should be directed to the production office, 5808 S. Rapp Street, Suite 209, Littleton, CO 80120.

Page Charges: *Economic Geology* has a voluntary page charge of \$80 per printed page. Many institutions, research groups, government agencies, companies, and other employers include funds for publication costs in their scientific budgets. Authors are asked to seek these or other funds for page charges.

Reprints: One hundred fifty reprints without covers of papers and scientific communications will be furnished free to authors paying full voluntary page charges. All other authors will receive 30 free reprints.
